The following are the minutes of the Regular Board Meeting of the Doña Ana Mutual Domestic Water Consumers Association Board of Directors, February 23, 2016, convened at 9:00 A.M. in the Doña Ana Mutual Domestic Water Consumers Association Board Room located at 5535 Ledesma Dr., Las Cruces, NM 88007:

Call to Order & Roll Call

President- Mr. Melton called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. and called roll:

Vice President- Jamie Stull, Excused Secretary/ Treasurer- Kurt Anderson, Present Board Member- Raymond Ponteri, Present

Approval of Agenda

Mr. Anderson moved to approve the agenda for the February 23, 2016 regular Board Meeting as presented; the motion was seconded by Mr. Ponteri. The Chair called for discussion of the motion; Mrs. Horton stated that the date of the minutes be changed from February 19, 2016 to February 9, 2016. Mr. Ponteri asked if it would be possible to move open board discussion to an earlier part of the meeting Mr. Melton explained the reasons

why the agenda is in a certain order and stated that the agenda would stay as presented. The Chair called for a vote on the motion; the motion carried by roll call vote 3-0.

Minutes

Mr. Anderson moved to approve the Regular Board Meeting Minutes of February 9, 2016 as presented; the motion was seconded by Mr. Ponteri. The Chair called for discussion of the motion. The Board of Directors requested minor changes are made to the minutes. The Chair called for a vote on the motion; the motion carried by roll call vote 3-0.

New Members & New Meters

Mr. Anderson moved to approve the New Members and New Meters list as presented; the motion was seconded by Mr. Ponteri. The Chair called for discussion of the motion: Mrs. Horton stated that there were five (5) new members and zero (0) new meters. The Chair called for a vote on the motion; the motion carried by roll call vote 3-0.

Customer Issues and Public Input

Mrs. Schreurs spoke with the Board of Directors about an issue with a price quote for meter installation that was given by Doña Ana MDWCA. Mrs. Horton explained that the price quote that was initially given was in 2014 and the policy that Doña Ana MDWCA is required to enforce was approved on January 26, 2016. This policy states that a connection fee of \$1,185 is to be charged to all new residences who request wastewater service in order to provide wastewater service to a property. The Board of Directors stated that they would discuss the item and that there would be an action item at the March 3, 2016 Board Meeting at which time they will make a decision.

Board President Report

Mr. Melton reports:

Mr. Melton reported that on February 16, 2016 he attended Colonias Day at the Legislature. Colonias Day is when the Colonias Infrastructure Funding is highlighted to the Legislators. The Colonias Infrastructure fund is a carve out fund along with the Tribal Infrastructure fund which provides that both entities receive that same amount of funding each year. Mr. Melton stated that Colonias Day was not well attended this year and he believes that the date was set too late in the session and by the time legislators got to this day they need to be in multiple locations at the same time. Mr. Melton reported that is FY 2017 there will approximately be 12 million dollars available which is down from 16 million dollars in FY 2016. Mr. Melton also noted that New Mexico Finance Authority (NMFA) Colonias Infrastructure would be switching over to an online application process to alleviate large amounts of paperwork. We were also urged to keep projects ready to be funded to keep the funding process moving smoothly.

Mr. Melton stated that the Governor talked about the Village of Cloudcroft and how they are almost done completing a multi-million dollar wastewater project that takes the city's wastewater and converts it to clean drinking water. It is expected to produce about 100,000 gallons a day with the capability to produce 250,000 gallons.

Staff Reports

Executive Director

Mrs. Horton reports- see attachment A

Mrs. Horton stated that she is excited to begin construction on all of the projects that are currently being funded. Mrs. Horton reported that we are currently in the process of drilling Well #11. The drilling company has managed to drill at least 60 feet deep but has broken a drill bit; drilling is expected to take a little longer than the projected two (2)

days. Mrs. Horton stated that she is urging the contractor on the Fairview Project to hang the water line across the bridge quickly because the Rio Grande may be filled before April 1, 2016.

General Legal Update- Mr. Peters noted that the Regional Water Utility Authority bills died in the legislature and he did not see anything coming out of the legislature that would affect the Association.

Open Discussion

Mr. Melton asked for a status update on the employee handbook that is being updated by a Personnel Attorney in Albuquerque. Mrs. Horton said that she would call the Attorney and find out the status of the new employee handbook.

Mr. Melton noted that the calendar on the homepage of the Doña Ana MDWCA website had been modified and he complemented Mrs. Horton for the good work on the calendar.

Mr. Anderson asked about well data and Mrs. Horton stated that operations staff is in the process of getting him the well data he requested.

Mr. Anderson asked if there would be and advantage of paying off our USDA loan for the North Tank Project. Mrs. Horton said she needs to find out which loan we should pay down between the north tank loan and the Ft. Selden loan. Mrs. Horton is considering paying down the loan that will be on our books for the shortest period of time.

Mr. Ponteri asked when bills are run each month if there is a summary of how many bills there were and the dollar amount for each bill. Mrs. Horton stated that she would get him a report for the total dollars billed.

Mr. Anderson asked how the new accounting clerk was doing with her responsibilities. Mrs. Horton stated that she was doing a great job and that she was able to run pay roll with very little help.

The Board of Directors discussed the customer issue concerning a price quote and a new policy. The Board decided that more research needs to be done and there would be an action item at the next regular Board Meeting.

• The revised plans were submitted to New Mexico Environmental Department (NMED) Construction Programs Bureau (CPB) and Doña Ana County (DAC) for review on February 10, 2016. NMED CPB approved the plans for bid on February 12, 2016. At this time, Doña Ana County has not provided any comments.
