Reporting Suspicious Activity

Should anyone see any suspicious activity around hydrants, meters or any of our facilities please contact Law Enforcement Authorities and our office at 575-526-3491. If after hours please contact our emergency on call operator at 575-644-4027.

If a scammer has tried to contact you, you should report it immediately to The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) by calling 1-877-382-4357 so they can start protecting and educate other consumers.

New Notification of Billing

Dona Ana Water's billing notification system launched a new update feature via email. This notification is simply a friendly reminder that you have an upcoming utility bill. If you have any questions or concerns please contact our office at 575-526-3491.

Water Conservation in the Kitchen

- Defrost food in the refrigerator rather that running it under the faucet.
- Wash your fruits and vegetables in a pot of water instead of running the water from the tap.
- Do not scrape pots and pans under running water, instead soak your pots to lift burnt on foods.
- Steaming your vegetables requires a lot less water than boiling.
- ♦ Use one glass to drink from each day. This cuts down on the number of glasses to wash.
- ♦ When washing dishes by hand, do not let the water run. Fill one sink with wash water and the other to rinse.

Policy Feature

Having our POLICY FEATURE in our Newsletter helps build relations with our customers through regular communication and better understanding about our policies at DAMDWCA.

Bulk Water Service

Available in the Doña Ana MDWCA water service area by permit for use in connection with the construction, alteration or repair of buildings or other similar activities requiring temporary service through hydrant meters.

To protect the water system from contamination, a backflow device (reduced pressure principle assembly) shall be required to be installed on the hydrant meter. Doña Ana MDWCA shall provide the backflow device. A deposit is required to be paid prior to the installation of the hydrant meter and backflow device.

User is responsible for any stolen, lost, or damaged meters and/or backflow devices and a new deposit will be required for each stolen, lost, damaged, or relocated bulk water meter and/or backflow device.
