Payment Options

With so much uncertainty, we know some customers might be worried about paying their bills. We understand the hardship local businesses and residents are facing. We will not be disconnecting customers for non-payment at this time. Please keep in mind that accounts with balances will continue to incur late penalties and nonpayment fees. We encourage our customers to continue making their payments to prevent additional fees on their accounts.

- <u>Drop Box:</u> 5535 Ledesma Dr. Las Cruces, NM 88007 This box will be checked several times a day to ensure payments are posted in a timely manner. Check or money order.
- <u>On-Line:</u> www.dawater.org: Payments can be made 24 hours a day. You will be required to have either registered the account or by quick pay. This could be done with either a credit/ debit card or e-check. Please be aware that there will be a surcharge of \$1.25 per transaction.
- Over the Phone: Effective July 1, 2020 we will no longer be taking over the phone payments, please use the IVR system. Dona Ana Water is asking our customers to use the exact change at this time due to the coin shortage. If you are paying with cash, any excess will be applied as a credit. We also take checks, debit and credit cards.

New Mexico Law requires everyone to call NM811 two days prior to starting any excavation project, no matter the size. NM811 is a free service for everyone to use to help locate underground utility lines. Examples are building a fence, landscaping, installing a pool, installing a sprinkler system. Once the lines are marked you can safely begin your dig.

Water Conservation Tips For Outdoor

- Winterize outdoor spigots when the temperature dips below 30 degrees to prevent your pipes from bursting and freezing.
- Plant in the spring and fall.
- Avoid planting grass in areas that are hard to water, such as inclines.
- Let your lawn go dormant during the winter months.
- Add a shut off nozzle to your garden hose.
- Recycle your grass clippings, this will retain water and nutrients.
- Weed your lawn and garden.

Wastewater Rates Policy

The time is soon approaching where we will begin the calculation of wastewater rates for 2021. We would like to remind all customers who receive wastewater services with Doña Ana MDWCA of the new wastewater calculation dates. Your annual wastewater calculations will be based on the following readings dates:

- November 15, 2020- December 15, 2020
- December 15, 2020—January 15, 2021
- January 15, 2021 February 15, 2021

During this time if you experience any water leaks the Association does have the ability to review your account for the possibility to make an adjustment on your wastewater calculation. You are required to provide proof that the leak occurred during the calculation review time and that the leak has been repaired.
